The pre-bid conference started at 10:00 a.m. It was held at the PCC Madamba Hall, Philippine Carabao Center, National Headquarters and Gene Pool, Science City of Munoz, Nueva Ecija. The attending members of the PCC BAC and the bidders were requested to sign the attendance sheet.

Four (4) bidders participated in the pre-bid conference.

The public bidding for the PCC requirements FY 2019 is in accordance with the DBM Circular Letter No. 2018-8 dated July 30, 2018 (Conduct of Early Procurement FY 2019 National Expenditure Program (NEP).

The Notice of Award will be issued to the winning bidder/supplier early January 2019 only upon approval of the respective appropriations or budget authorization document and based on the amount authorized herein. Suppliers are required to submit their Performance Security on or before the 10th day from receipt of the Notice of Award.

Dr. Annabelle S. Sarabia, BAC Chairperson, presided the pre-bidding conference. Details of the PCC project/s for bidding were read, specifically, the approved budget for the contract, contract duration, deadline of submission of bid proposals and the venue of the bid opening.

The bidder was instructed to use the dog ear codes as indicated in the Bid Data Sheet marked as Annex “B” for easy reference of the BAC.

ITB Clause 21

The deadline of submission of bid proposals will be on **November 19, 2018 (9:00 a.m.) - Philippine Standard Time (PST)** at the BAC Secretariat Office, Philippine Carabao Center, National Headquarters and Gene Pool, Science City of Munoz, Nueva Ecija. Bidders may submit their bid proposals on or before the deadline. Late bids shall not be accepted.

ITB Clause 28.3(a)

Each item will be evaluated and compared with other bids separately and recommended to form complete contract separately.

The bidder was also instructed to include brochures, catalogues, literatures and if available website of manufacturer of the item being offered as part of the Technical Documents and will be used during the evaluation/validation of the PCC Technical Working Group. (refer to Technical Specifications of the bidding documents).

The **BAC Chairperson** reiterated that No. 8 (d) of the Omnibus Sworn Statement states that “the bidder is aware of and has undertaken the following responsibilities as a bidder to inquire or secure Supplemental/Bid Bulletin(s) issued for the specific project”. It was also reiterated that as per Revised IRR of RA 9184 Section 22.5.3 states that “any Supplemental/Bid Bulletin issued by the BAC shall also be posted on the PhilGEPS and the website of the procuring entity concerned, if available. It shall be the responsibility of all those who have properly secured the Bidding Documents to inquire and secure Supplemental/Bid Bulletins that may be issued by the BAC. However, bidders who have submitted bids before the issuance of the Supplemental/Bid Bulletin must be informed and allowed to modify or withdraw their bids in accordance with Section 26.1 of the IRR.

The **BAC Chairman** reiterated the use of the attached/prescribed financial bid form together with the template “for Goods offered abroad” or “for Goods offered within the Philippines”.

As agreed, the BAC will issue bid bulletin for the revision/updating of the technical specifications as follows.

A. Minimum Equipment and Tool Requirements

- The bidder must specify the brand of the five (5) pieces Caliber 9mm or .38 (firearm) and must be supported by appropriate license and documents

B. Manpower Requirements

- The Physical and Medical Examination of the fifteen (15) security guards to be assigned must be inclusive of Psycho Test and Drug Test

Supply and delivery of Buffalo Feed Concentrates (4,957 bags) 1 lot

No bidder attended the pre-bid conference for the project.
