TERMS OF REFERENCE AND CONDITIONS

Approved Budget for the Contract	Five Million Pesos (P 5,000,000.00)

Definition of Similar contract	Similar contract refers to project/s that involves supply and delivery livestock animals
Minimum Requirements for Bidders	It is understood that the animals to be offered must be complying with the specifications called for.
	 The bidder must have completed a single contract within the last five (5) years similar to the project equivalent to at least fifty percent (50%) of the ABC amounting to (P 2,500,000.00) OR
	Completed at least two (2) similar contracts, the aggregate amount of which should be equivalent to at least fifty percent (50%) of the ABC and the largest of these similar contracts must be at least half of the percentage of ABC required above amounting to (1,250,000.00).

TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS

- A. BREED: Native Carabao (If Heifer or First Parity)
 - I. Age, weight and others:
 - 1. Age: 3-5 years old
 - 2. Weight: not less than 350 kgs or above
 - 3. BCS: not less than 3.5
 - 4. In good health condition
 - 5. The animal should be identified through proper eartags
 - 6. Complete animal documents (livestock credentials)
 - 7. Vaccinated with Hemorraghic Septicemia (Certification of Veterinarian)
 - 8. Surra/Brucella Tested (Certification of Veterinarian)
 - 9. The supplier will be liable in the event of animal death during delivery to the procuring entity
 - 10. Weighing of animals will be conducted by the procuring entity upon delivery of animals prior to their acceptance

II. Physical Conformation of Heifer:

1. Good physical condition with no congenital abnormalities, physical defects and deformities

III. Health Condition of Heifers:

- 1. The health condition of the animals should be in accordance with DA Administrative Order No. 13 "Guidelines on the Transport/Shipment of Hog, Cattle, Carabao, Sheep and Goats and Other Cloven-footed Animals, their Meat and Meat Products, Animal Products and By-products in and between Luzon, Visayas and Mindanao".
- 2. The cost of tests as required and as stipulated in DA AO13 shall be borne by PCC. The animals must be certified and tested negative at the time of delivery. All laboratory tests must be performed by PCC and other government laboratories identified by the Agency as necessary.

The following tests that will be conducted are:

- 1. Bovine Tuberculosis: Intradermal Tuberculin Test
- 2. Brucella: Rose Bengal Plate Test (RBPT)
- 3. *Trypanosoma evansi* Test : Micro-Hematocrit Centrifugation Technique (MCHT)/Polymerase Chain Reaction (PCR)
- 4. Fecalysis: Sedimentation and Flotation Technique
- 3. Additional certification that the animals have been vaccinated against Hemorrhagic Septicemia at least two weeks before delivery is required and certified by a government veterinarian.
- 4. Other tests or medications not specified and maybe required by PCC such as deworming for external and internal parasites shall be for the account of the

contractor.

IV. Transport Vehicle:

- 1. Transport shall be done using a specialized livestock vehicle. The contractor must have a valid livestock handler's license issued by the Bureau of Animal Industry (BAI).
- 2. The contractor must have a valid transport carrier license as a livestock and by-products transport carrier issued by the Bureau of Animal Industry (BAI).

V. Delivery:

- 1. The contractor shall notify PCC at least one week in advance of the proposed date of delivery. Expenses for the transport of the animal to the delivery site (FOB) as stated in the TOR must be shouldered by the contractor.
- 2. The animal to be delivered should be roped tamed (8 meters in length with 0.5 inches diameter)
- 3. Pre-delivery inspection:
 - a. Individual animal credential and identification such as eartag and picture should be taken during pre-inspection
 - b. Individual weighing should be done with the presence of selection and inspection team during pre-delivery period.

VI. Others:

- 1. The contractor must have a valid Animal Welfare Act (AWA) Registration Certificate issued by the Bureau of Animal Industry (BAI) in compliance with RA 8485 also known as the Animal Welfare Act of 1998.
- 2. The contractor must have a valid Environmental Compliance Certificate (ECC) for the project issued by the Environmental Management Bureau (EMB).
- 3. Origin of animals: Preferably the source of animals should be within Visayas and Mindanao

B. BREED: Native Carabao (If Pregnant)

I. Age, weight and others:

- 1. Age: 3-5 years old
- 2. Weight: not less than 350 kgs
- 3. BCS: not less than 3.5
- 4. In good health condition
- 5. Animal ID: The animal should be identified thru proper eartags
- Other requirement: Preferably pregnant (Note: All animals shall be subjected for pregnancy diagnosis). The respective recipient PC Center shall be in charge of pregnancy diagnosis.

- 7. Complete animal documents (livestock credentials)
- 8. Vaccinated with Hemorraghic Septicemia (Certification of Veterinarian)
- 9. Surra/Brucella Tested (Certification of Veterinarian)
- 10. The supplier will be liable in the event of animal death during delivery to the procuring entity
- 11. Weighing of animals will be conducted by the procuring entity upon delivery of animals prior to their acceptance
